## RECOMMENDED

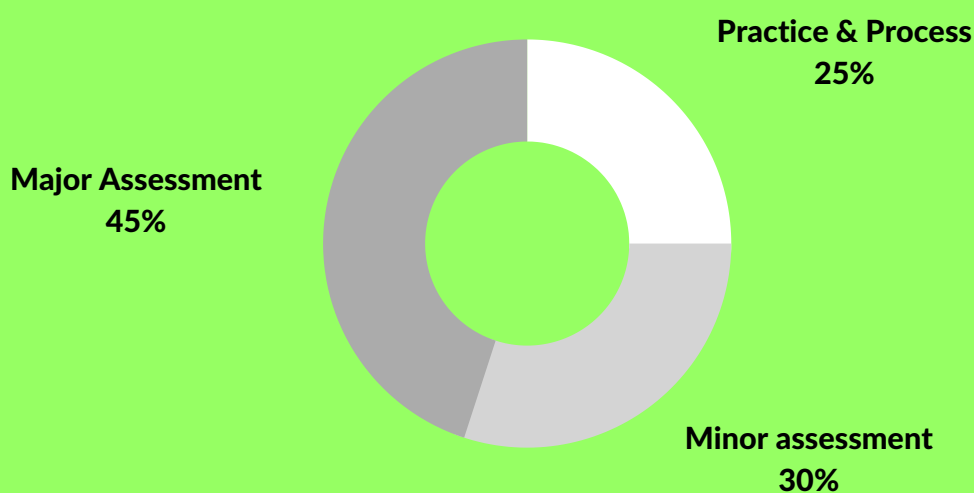
- paper to take notes

- Stay during office hours or contact the teacher for help



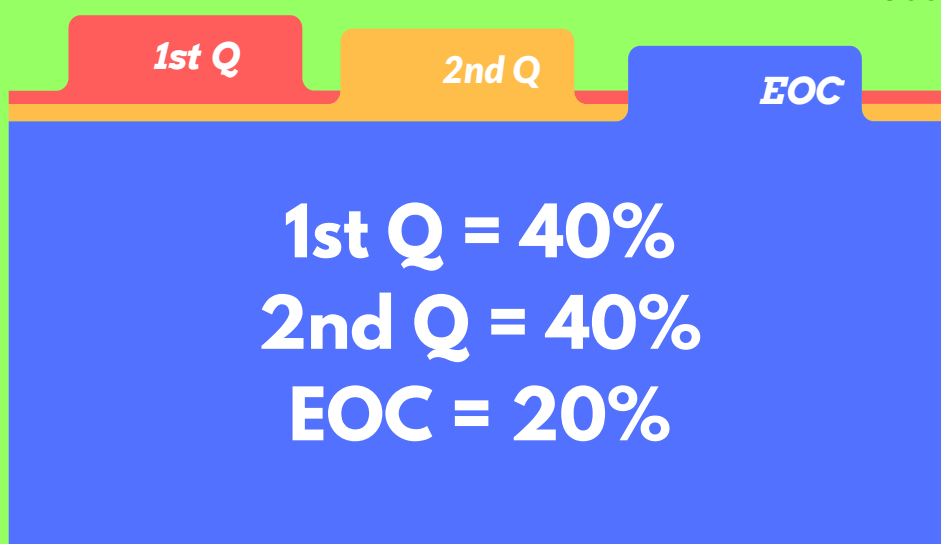
Even if you miss a live session, you should make every effort to know what you missed.
