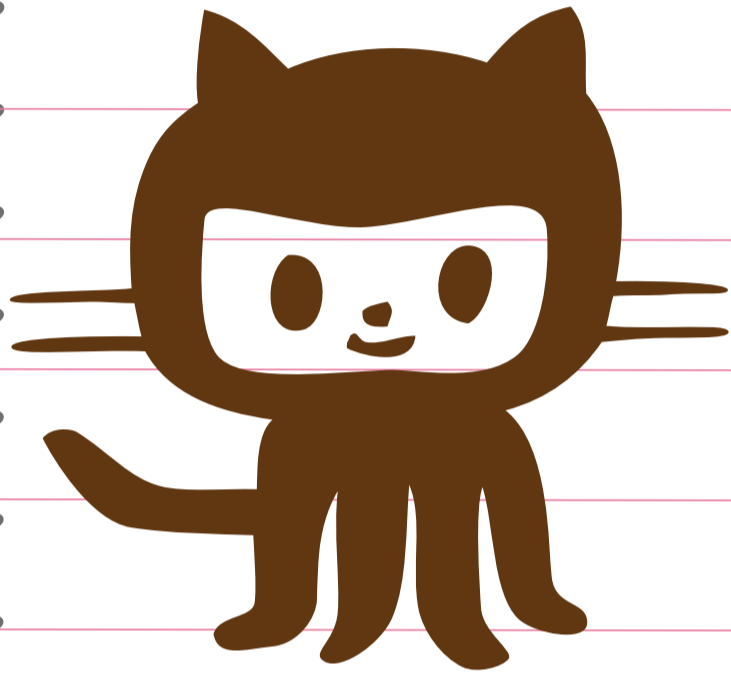


ADJECTIVES

big

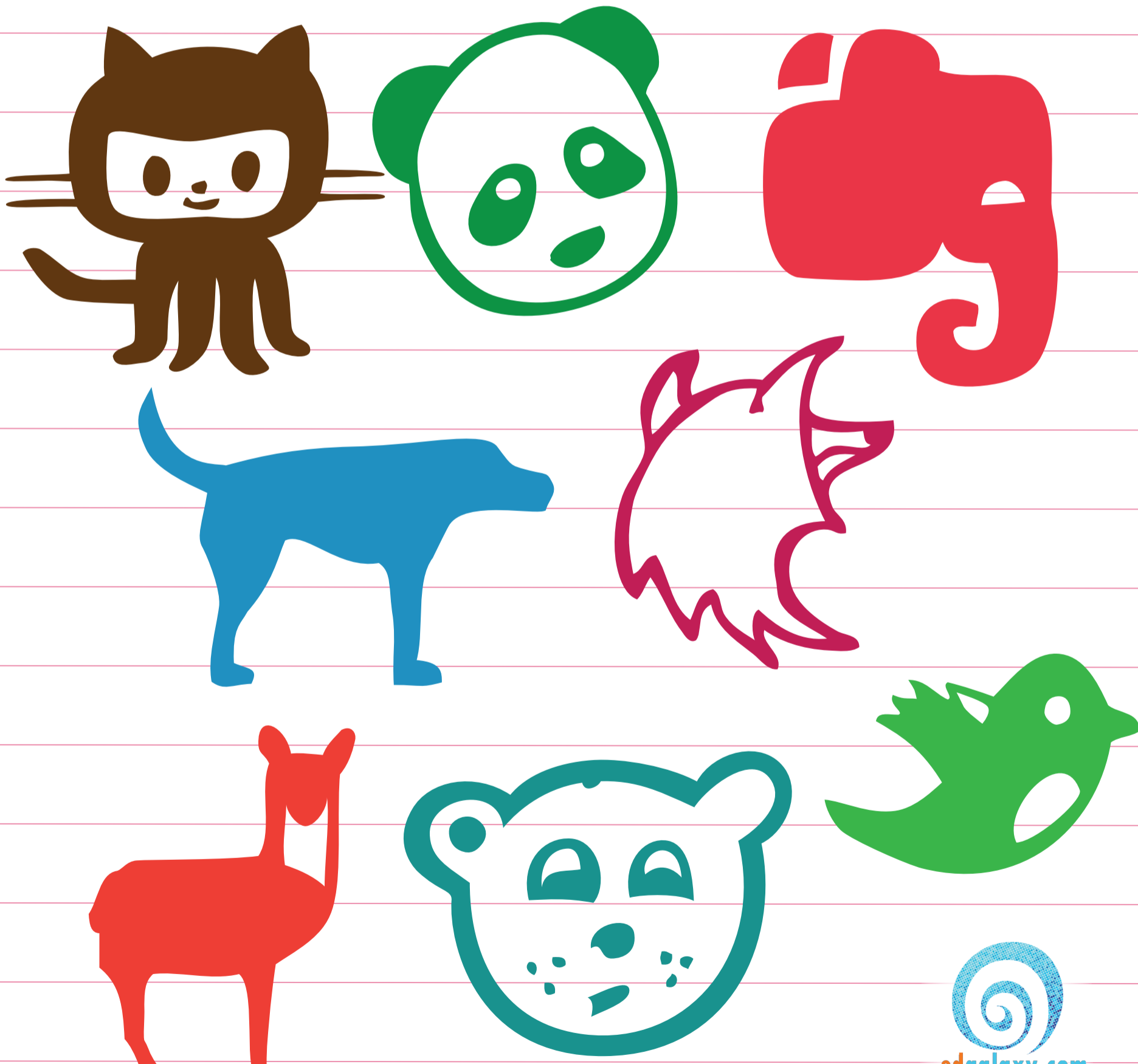
sweet



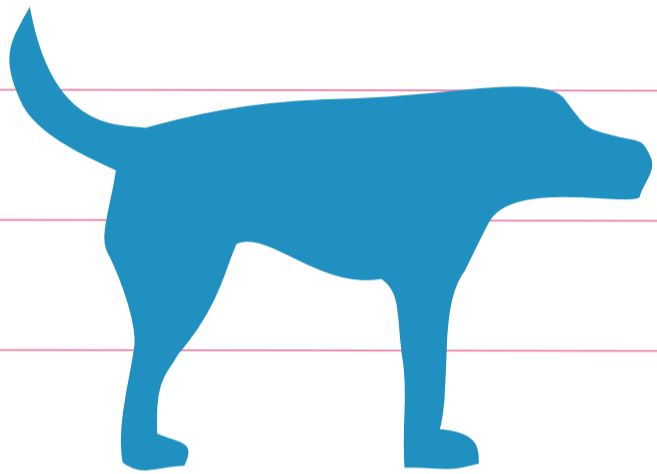
beautiful

Names a
person, place,
thing, or idea

Examples: book

rocket



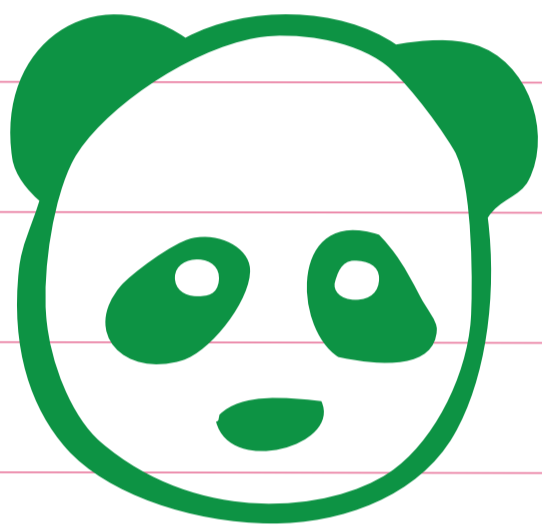
science

ADVERBS



Modifies a verb, an adjective, or another adverb and answers these questions: when? where? how? how much? why?

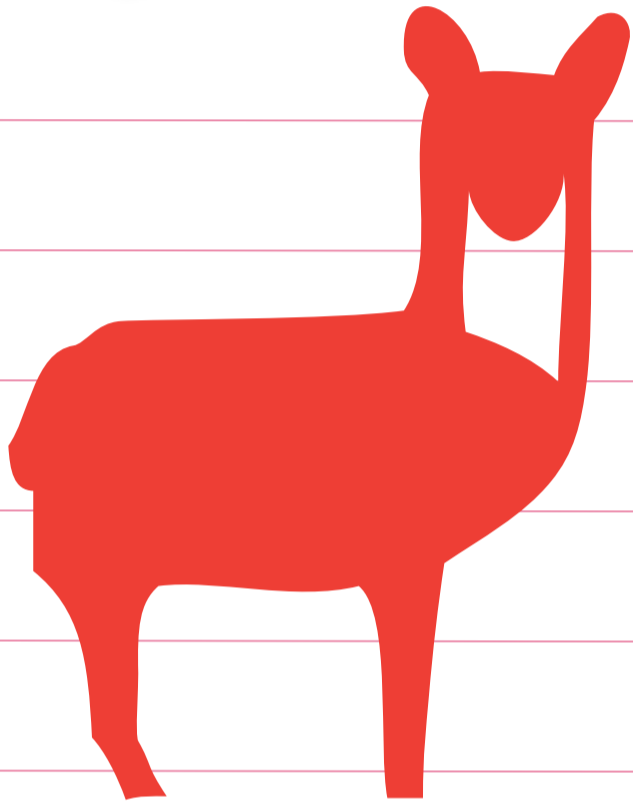
Examples: wildly

brightly 

beautifully



INTERJECTION

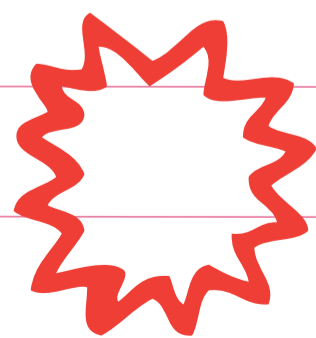


Expresses emotion and has no grammatical relation to the rest of the sentence

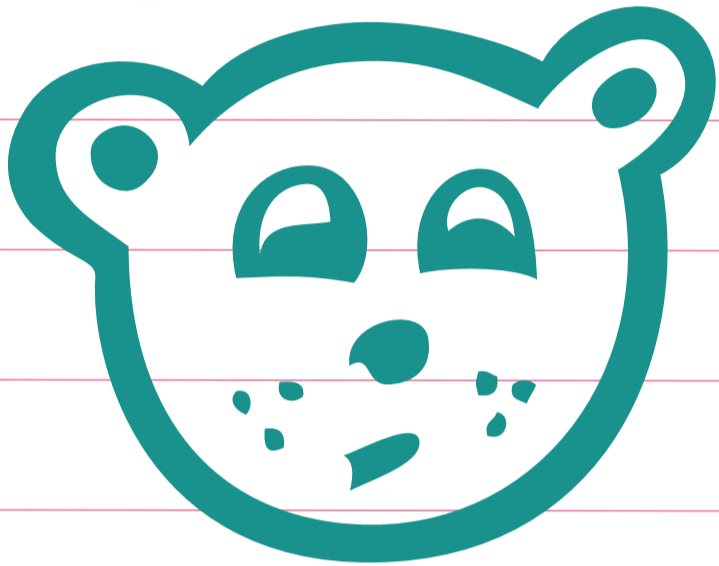
Examples: hello!

yikes! ouch!

oh my!



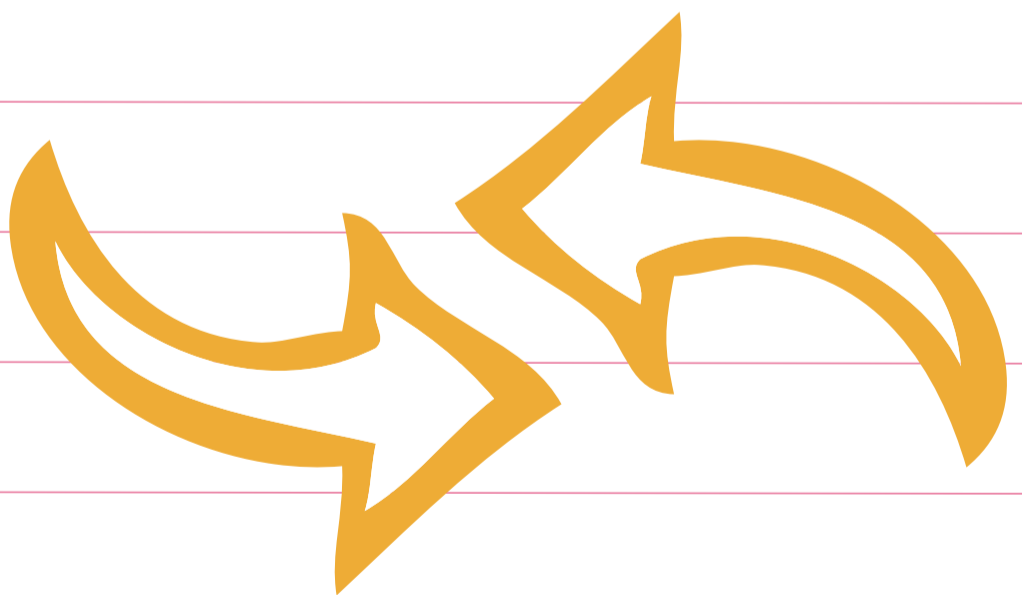
CONJUNCTION



Joins words or groups of words (phrases or clauses)

Examples: as

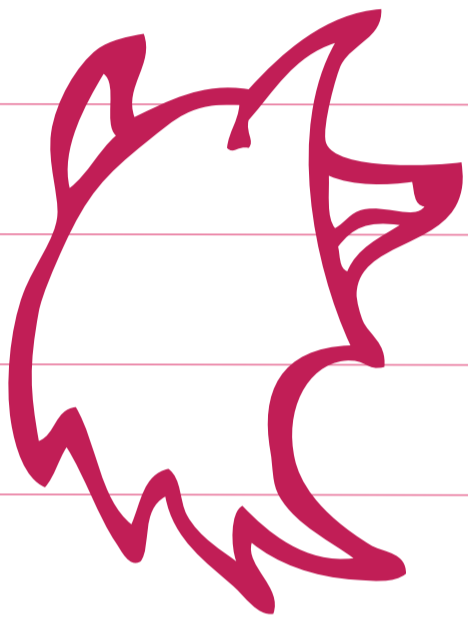
and

PREPOSITIONS

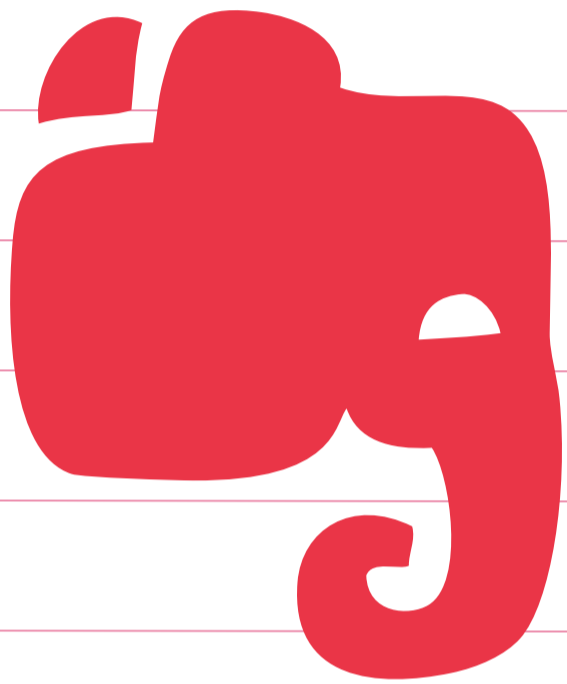


Shows the relationship of a noun or a pronoun to some other word in a sentence

Examples: OF

beside ↗ over
for ↘ under

PRONOUN



Is used in place of one or more nouns or pronouns

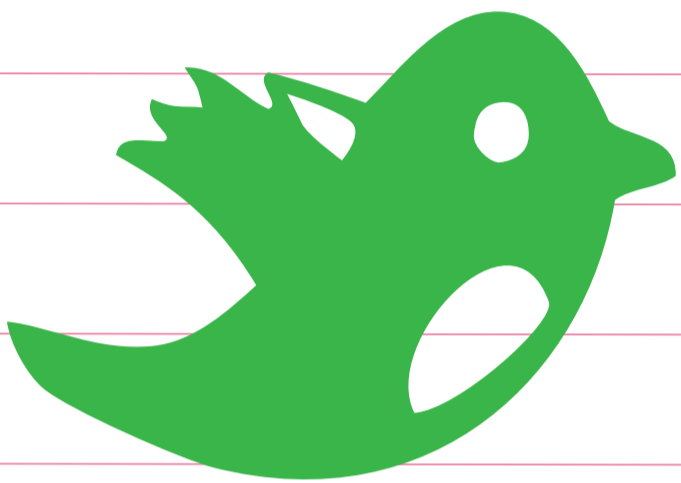
Examples: he

she it they

VERB



Expresses an action or a state of being

Examples: poke

eat  run
spit

scream
