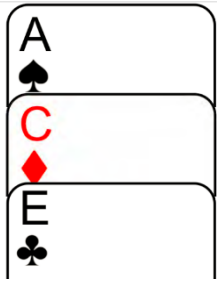

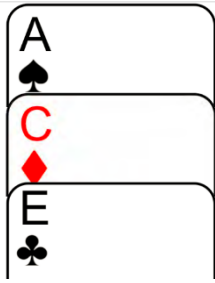
“What #firstsevenjobs Says About Today’s Young Adults and the Job Market”

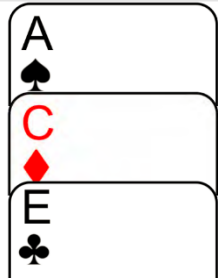

“The Health Benefits of Expressive Writing”

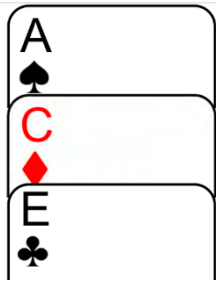
