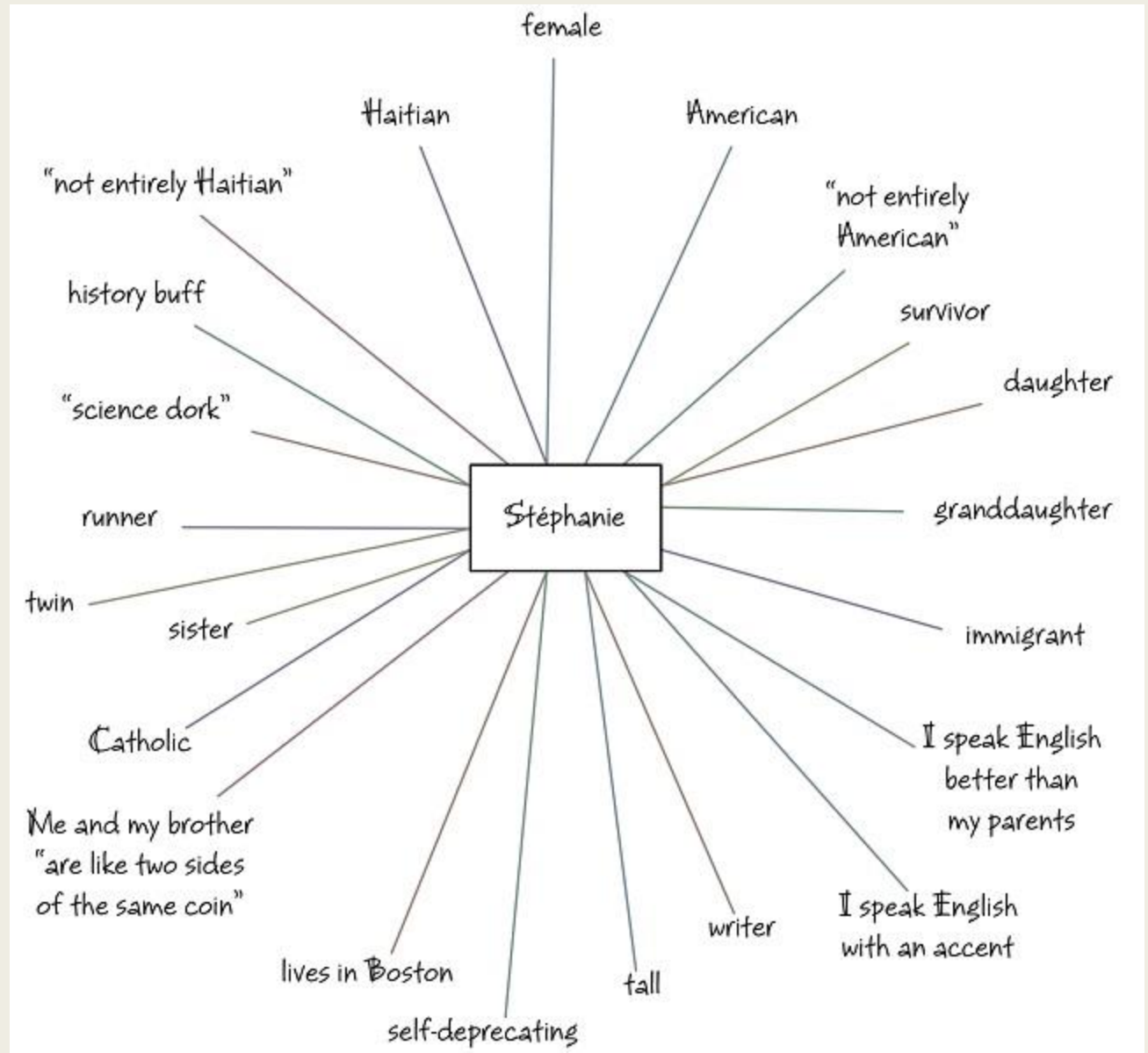
Connecting vocabulary
