



POETRY MASH-UP

The task: Set lines from Rudyard Kipling's "If" to scenes from CHS.

Step One: Read the poem and annotate it.

Step Two: Working as a panel, choose **10** lines or phrases that stand out.

Step Three: As a team, discuss and plan **10** places where you can take pictures around campus that set the scene for the lines you chose in step two. The pictures may include people posing for the scene, but they must be aware and give their consent.

Step Four: One member of the group will need to upload the photos to an email or Google Drive (something you can access easily online). Remember, you will need to have access to these when you create your presentation.

Step Five: Check out a laptop from me. One member from the panel will log in and go to **haikudeck.com**. Set up a free public account. All you need is an email address. If it asks for a credit card, you clicked on the wrong thing and need to see me.

Step Six: Using the Haiku Deck editor, create a new deck. It's easy, but if you need help, please ask. Try the help button first! You will have **11** slides total. Number 1 should include each panel member's name. The rest will be your lines and pictures.

Step Seven: When you are finished editing, click the play button on the deck. It should open in a new window. Copy the link in the presentation window and email it to me. (Links should look like the following: <https://haikudeck.com/untitled-haikudeck-uncategorized-presentation-df0980af0f>).

You will have approximately 30 minutes on Thursday as well as whatever time is left after the poetry terms test on Friday. All decks must be emailed to me by **Friday afternoon**.

Criticize the poem.

Collaborate on ideas.

Communicate through pictures.

Create something new.
