

Malicious

desiring to harm others or to see others suffer; ill-willed; spiteful

Melancholic

characterized by or causing or expressing sadness

Melodramatic

exaggerated and emotional or sentimental; overdramatic

Moralistic

Characterized by or displaying a concern with morality; narrowly and conventionally moral

Nonplussed

totally puzzled, perplexed, or confused

Obdurate

unmoved by persuasion, pity, or tender feelings; stubborn; unyielding; stubbornly resistant to moral influence

Obsequious

overly obedient and/or submissive

Patronizing

displaying or indicative of an offensively condescending manner

Pedantic

ostentatious in one's learning; overly concerned with minute details or formalisms, esp. in teaching

Pensive

dreamily or wistfully thoughtful; expressing or revealing thoughtfulness, usually marked by some sadness
