

There are nineteen words total in units 9 & 10. These activities are designed to strengthen your familiarity with and ability to use the words correctly before our review test. Complete one activity per day in any order you wish. This is a graded assignment.

Day one

Using the words from units 9 & 10, write a sentence about someone you know. Make sure you show the meaning of the word.

"Joe is TRUCULENT" is not a good sentence. **X**

"Joe is TRUCULENT in the morning, always getting angry at the slightest noise or interruption" **shows that you know the meaning of the word.**

Day two

For each word, provide a contextual situation.

- People are APPREHENSIVE when they have to go to court for a traffic ticket.
- Someone's words might be EXPLICIT when explaining a difficult concept.

Day three

For each word, create a NON example.

SCORN does **not** mean to congratulate or cheer on.

Day four

For each of the words, create a simile.

A BELLIGERENT tone is **like** cannons firing at an enemy.
