You may work alone or with a partner to write a narrative poem that meets the following requirements:

- Choose a topic
- Determine a theme
- Select the speaker and point of view
- Set a tone
- Include one of each of the following
 - \diamond personification
 - ✤a simile or metaphor
 - Rhyme or alliteration

Example

- Topic- Halloween
- Theme- Everyone can enjoy themselves
- Speaker & pov- child / 3rd person
- Tone- Whimsical
- Include one of each of the following
 - personification- the pumpkins grinned and blinked
 a simile or metaphor- the night as black as a witch's hat
 Rhyme or alliteration-happy haunting hobgoblins

Write the poem in 3-5 stanzas wherein there is a beginning, middle, and end.

- Underline or highlight your personification, simile/metaphor, rhyme/alliteration.
- Include a title as well as a description of the theme and tone.
