




Writing a narrative poem




You may work alone or with a partner to write a narrative poem that meets the following requirements:

- Choose a topic
- Determine a theme
- Select the speaker and point of view
- Set a tone
- Include one of each of the following
 - ❖ personification
 - ❖ a simile or metaphor
 - ❖ Rhyme or alliteration



Example

- **Topic**- Halloween
- **Theme**- Everyone can enjoy themselves
- **Speaker & pov**- child / 3rd person
- **Tone**- Whimsical
- **Include one of each of the following**
 - ❖ **personification**- the pumpkins grinned and blinked
 - ❖ **a simile or metaphor**- the night as black as a witch's hat
 - ❖ **Rhyme or alliteration**-happy haunting hobgoblins

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- Write the poem in 3-5 stanzas wherein there is a beginning, middle, and end.
 - Underline or highlight your personification, simile/metaphor, rhyme/alliteration.
 - Include a title as well as a description of the theme and tone.
